Pollination Card Sort 3/2/17

1. Pollinator lands on a flower
2. Pollen is found on the anther of a flower
3. Pollen from the anther sticks to a pollinator
4. The pollinator flies to another flower
5. Pollen from the pollinator falls onto the sticky stigma
6. A pollen tube grows from the stigma down the style
7. The pollen tube reaches the ovary and ovules
8. The ovules are fertilized by pollen from the pollen tube
9. The ovules become seeds and the ovary becomes a fruit
10. The seed will grow into a plant
